Dear Holy Family Parents,

Thank you for your continued patience and understanding as we navigate new information and directives concerning COVID-19. Our prayers and thoughts are with those throughout the world who have been affected by this situation.

Effective today, the Diocese has directed the following:

- 1) All school-related travel outside the Commonwealth of Kentucky will be suspended till further notice.
- 2) Schools will follow directives from their county and local Health Department (Ashland/Boyd County) as well as follow the lead of county and local school systems. (Ashland, Boyd, and Greenup)
- 3) ALL school activities will be cancelled when schools are closed; this includes athletic events, plays, clubs, and all other events.
- 4) As directed by Governor Andy Beshear all schools are to implement a ten day Virtual/EDays while they are closed.

**** WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR HOLY FAMILY SCHOOL?**

For now, Holy Family School will be closed Mon., March 16th through April 3rd. This is subject to change depending on the COVID-19 spread or containment. We will meet with School Council to determine what to do about Spring Break which was originally scheduled for April 6-10th. I do know we will not have school on Friday, April 10th as that is Good Friday.

Remember to wash hands, use water bottles instead of drinking from water fountains, stay home, and stay away from crowded venues and large gatherings. Let's stop the spread of COVID-19! Oh and most of all stay safe and pray.

Our number one priority is the health and safety of our students. We remain committed to that as we navigate together this new challenging situation. I will continue to update you in a timely manner.
