Art, Music and Library News - September 6th-9th

We had a great short week in art, music and library. Please remember to send an oversized shirt with your student to be left at school if you have not yet sent one. We will be using messy materials in the upcoming weeks. Also please remember to send in your art and music fees if you have not done so.

Sketchbooks are due every Thursday. The assignment for 3rd-5th is to draw a landscape of your choice. The middle and high school sketchbook assignment is to pick an adjective and draw a still life that expresses that adjective. For example, drippy, floral and fruity are adjectives that can be used.

Art classes are finishing up their units on still life drawing. This week we explored drawing with oil and chalk pastels. Early elementary students have really enjoyed our new unit on landscape and architecture. They started working on a project that uses popsicle sticks to design a house in a landscape.

In the music room students have been learning some hymns out of the church hymnal. Middle school students led the opening and closing hymn in Friday's mass. Students will take turns introducing the hymns in mass on Friday. This Friday the early elementary students will sing Jesus Loves Me for the opening hymn.

Remember to bring your library books back every Tuesday. Third through Fifth graders are required to do a short, impromptu talk about a book they check out from the library every nine weeks. This is a way for them to practice speaking in front of the class. Also, I want to do this to encourage students to explore the library and get excited about reading.
