<b>Yo</b> (I)	<b>Nosotros</b> (we)
<b>Tú</b> (you *informal)	<b>Vosotros</b> (you *plural, used in Spain)
<b>Él</b> (he) <b>Ella</b> (she) <b>Usted</b> (you *more respectful)	<b>Ellos</b> (they) <b>Ellas</b> (they *all girls) <b>Ustedes</b> (you *plural, used in Latin America)

**Cultura** (Culture): Greeting people in other countries:

-**In Bolivia:** People pat each other on the shoulder, shake hands, and then pat each other again.

-**In El Salvador:** It is very common for women to pat each other on the arms and shoulders, and not shake hands all together.
